



Eyelash Extensions

Reduce cosmetic application time and wake up to gorgeous!

Eyelash Extensions are synthetic fibers attached to your own lashes, one by one, to **add length, curl and volume.**

They are soft, light weight and flexible. Best of all, no one will suspect you are wearing them.



PRE-TREATMENT

Prior to your first eyelash extension service, you must schedule a consultation. At this complimentary appointment, the technician will determine the length and thickness of lashes that'll be used to meet your desired results.

Please ask any questions that you have about the application and maintenance during this visit.

Arrive 15 minutes before your first eyelash extension appointment to allow adequate time to complete your questionnaire.

Please remove your contact lenses prior to your appointment.

You must arrive to your appointment **without make-up.**

Your full set eyelash extension appointment may take up to two hours. Due to the nature of the application process, you will need to remain lying on your back for the entire appointment. Please address any concerns about this requirement with your technician.

We use the safest, highest performing eyelash extensions on the market with a medical-grade adhesive that's produced in an FDA-certified facility.

POST-TREATMENT

Follow the care instructions for the maximum life of your eyelash extensions.

Avoid showering or washing eyes 24 hours after the initial application. Use care to avoid splashing water or cleanser in the eye area when washing your face.

Do not swim or use tanning beds, hot tubs, steam rooms or saunas for the first 48 hours after application to allow for complete bonding.

Avoid sleeping directly on your lashes; note that the side you normally sleep on is more susceptible to shedding.

Be gentle with your lashes, avoid touching, rubbing or pulling on your extensions. The natural oils from your hands will break down the adhesive bond, plus any action that repeatedly puts stress or strain on your eyelash extensions will cause them to shed prematurely.

Avoid getting non-oil free moisturizers, eye creams or makeup removers on or around your lash extensions.

Avoid any cosmetic product or cleanser containing organic solvents, urea, glycols, or high concentrations of alcohol.

Do not use liquid, cream or pencil eyeliners; cake or powder is recommended.

Do not use waterproof mascara! Only use eyelash extension approved mascara and only apply to the tips. The repeated use of mascara may shorten the lifespan of your eyelash extensions by compromising the adhesive bonds.

Do not curl eyelash extensions; they are pre-curved. Additional curling is not necessary and doing so may shorten the lifespan of your extensions by compromising the adhesive bond.

The aforementioned activities and products can potentially break down the adhesive bond and shorten the duration of time your eyelash extensions stay adhered. Your technician can advise you on the products we carry for Eyelash Extension maintenance.

It is normal to experience loss/shedding of eyelash extensions due to natural shedding. The complete eyelash growth cycle is composed of three unique phases, which includes the natural shedding phase of eyelashes.

We recommend fill appointments every two to three weeks to replace damaged and old extensions.
