

INJECTABLE FAQ: BOTOX, DYSPORT & FILLERS

- **In what instances can injectable procedures NOT be performed?**

Includes, but not limited to:

- Active Herpes breakout on the face
- Active infection
- Pregnancy
- Allergy to any similar injectables

- **Is a consultation and/or paper work required prior to my appointment?**

Your consultation will be conducted at the beginning of your scheduled appointment and will include any necessary consent forms. It is rare for someone to be deemed ineligible for an injectable procedure except where noted above.

- **What medications should be discontinued before having an injectable procedure?**

Nothing specific, however if you are taking aspirin or blood thinners it will increase your risk of bruising.

- **Are there any possible injectable side effects?**

Common side effects are possible bruising, an allergic reaction (although rare) and facial asymmetries. Side effects will be addressed thoroughly at the beginning of the appointment during the consultation.

- **In the rare event I experience side effects or have a concern, who should I contact?**

If you have a concern regarding your injectable procedure, contact your nurse injector Kim Starr directly via phone (763-331-1606) or email (kimstarr@comcast.net). Please, DO NOT contact Simonson's Salon & Spa; doing so will only delay Kim's response time.
